

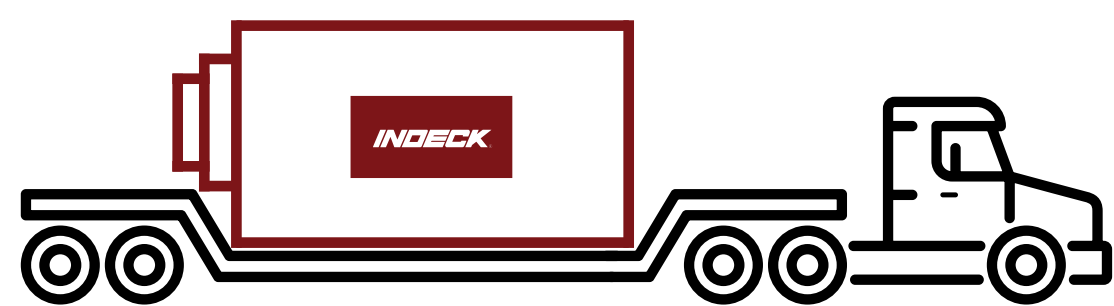

Insurance terms vary depending on facility and use. As such, it is the responsibility of the lessee to provide liability and property insurance.

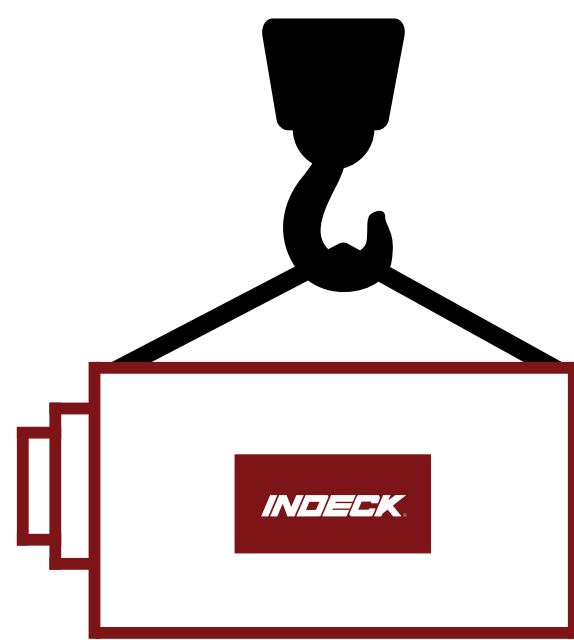
Freight
